The CETA *Education Foundation* ("the Foundation") is proud to announce it will be providing scholarships to applicants for the school year of 2017-2018. The Foundation's intention is to offer six (6), \$3500 scholarships to CETA Members in good standing, their employees and their families.

Two scholarships will be awarded in each of the following eligible membership classes: Manufacturers, Suppliers and Distributors. In the event a qualified applicant is not identified in one of these classes, the Trustees will award the scholarship(s) to the next highest ranking applicant, regardless of his or her membership class.

In addition, the Foundation will provide a \$1,000 incentive award to all six recipients providing their sponsors have exhibited in the CETA Pavilion (for Manufacturers and Suppliers) or the CETA Annual Convention (for Distributors). The Foundation will also provide one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to be awarded to one of the 2016-2017 scholarship winners for the highest GPA.

As it has in the past, the Foundation will use the same independent university scholarship professor to grade the applications. All applications must be post marked by April 28, 2017.

The Foundation can fund these scholarships through a variety of activities. Members who use the CETA endorsed Lease Consultants Programs earn rebates for the Foundation for each lease financed. the Great Diamond Give-A-Way and CETA's Annual Convention Golf Tournament (when available) also help fund the Foundation's efforts. The generosity from the CETA Members and the tax deductible individual contributions also help provide these awards to the deserving students.

Through these activities, the Foundation has been able to provide one hundred and nine (109) scholarships over the past twenty (21) years! It is the desire of the Trustees to grow this program with additional and on-going support so deserving students will be able to receive these scholarships in years to come. We would like to take this opportunity to extend our sincere gratitude and appreciation to everyone who has made this program possible!

Scholarship AwardInstructions 2017/2018 School Year

It is the intention of the CETA Education Foundation to award six (6) scholarships to qualified applicants in a fair and impartial manner. To be considered for a scholarship, the applicant must be a full-time student for the 2017/2018 school year at a College, Community College, Technical College, University or Graduate School. The Foundation will award two scholarships in each of the following eligible membership classes: Manufacturers, Suppliers & Distributors. Scholarships will be awarded based on independent ranking of applicants by an independent evaluator at an accredited university. In the event a qualified applicant cannot be identified in one or more of the membership classes, the Trustees will award a scholarship "At Large" to the remaining applicant(s) with the highest ranking(s) regardless of his or her membership class.

To be considered for a CETA scholarship award, your completed application must be post marked by April 28, 2017. Applications must be complete. Evaluation and selection will be based on the following criteria:

MATERIALS TO BE FURNISHED BY THE CANDIDATE:

- 1. Application Form
- 2. Completed Essay Form
- 3. Activity and Leadership Record
- 4. Work Activity Record

DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUPPLIED TO THE CETA EDUCATION FOUNDATION DIRECTLY FROM INSTRUCTORS AT THE REQUEST OF THE CANDIDATE:

- 1. Official high school or college/university transcript.
- 2. Official SAT, ACT, GRE, GMAT, or LSAT test scores.
- 3. UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS must supply evaluations from Science/Mathematics and Humanities Instructors.
 (If time constraints do not allow completion of this section, please explain reasons in writing.)

PLEASE NOTE: Applicants are responsible for assuring all transcripts, test scores, etc., are post marked by April 28, 2017.

CETA Education Foundation scholarship awards will be sent directly to the cashier of each recipient's college or university. The awards are not renewable; however, candidates may reapply in successive years.

The top six scoring applicants based on the rules will each be awarded a scholarship. In the case of a tie, the scholarship award will be shared equally among the tied applicants.
